Not long to go before the students and staff go on an Expedition to Kaazi on 24th-25th September 2011!!!. It has been long awaited and is almost here. Students who are interested in going but have not yet signed up for it or paid the fee, please do so in the Finance office as soon as possible.

In preparation for the Expedition, we shall do a pre-expedition hike on the weekend before (that is, 17th September 2011) on one of the many beautiful trails in the Mabira Forest Reserve. Mabira Forest is 54km from Kampala and 20km from Jinja. Entrance fees into the Forest to do the trail is approximately Ushs6000. All interested students, staff and parents are welcome to come along for this and are encouraged to sign up for this by **Thursday 17th September 2011** (sign up at the Reception) at the latest in order to plan and book transport accordingly. We shall leave from school at 7am returning around noon.
